Introduction to the natural environment and agricultural production of Northeast China

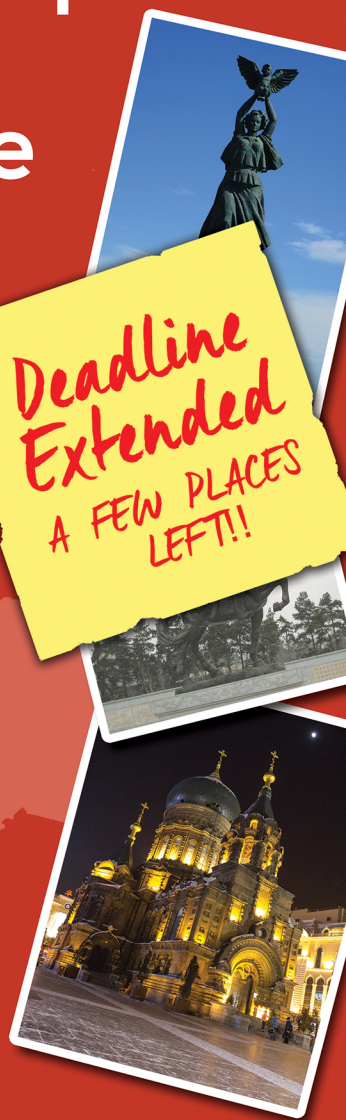
Day trips to villages around Harbin for in-depth exposure to folk religion and ethnic minority culture
